What is verified now

- ✓ The public site shows a 31 August 2026 morning edition with 11 Daily Editorial tabs and release ID OTR-DAILY-75-2026-08-31-083000-SGT.
- ✓ The public Headlines page shows only 8 items. All 8 are Reuters links. Two are dated 28 August and one is dated 26 August, so the page does not meet the requested rolling 24-hour, multilingual or per-engine standard.
- ✓ The Founder Ledger reads 52 HIT, 31 MISS, 83 resolved and 62.65% accuracy. Ten UNVERIFIABLE records remain excluded.
- ✓ The current public prediction cohort contains exactly three bearish crypto calls published at 8:36 am SGT and resolving at 4:36 am SGT on 1 September. Those rows remain immutable.
- ✓ The Graph page has 48 investibles and preserves prediction and source-timed headline history.
- ✓ The archive rule is append-only: a new release may supersede an older release but cannot overwrite its evidence state.
- ✓ A prior authenticated admin receipt captured 15 visible tabs, a 75-engine registry and a 24-native-language source registry. That receipt is a baseline, not permission to skip reading the current admin.

CANONICAL LIVE READ

Energy is the strongest positive pocket. Long bonds and small caps are the weakest broad signals. NVIDIA is the clearest large-technology exception. Gold is not acting as a simple safe haven.

What the live tape says

- USO +2.35% while SPY, QQQ and IWM were lower: the energy shock is stronger than the broad market.
- TLT -0.76% and GLD -0.56%: higher-rate and inflation expectations are still overpowering classic defensive assets.
- IWM -0.94% versus SPY -0.44% and QQQ -0.18%: smaller companies are carrying more pressure.
- NVIDIA +1.14% while Apple, Meta and Alphabet were lower: AI-compute demand is creating narrow relative strength, not a broad technology rally.
- A current AP market report and Reuters gold reporting described the same oil-up, stocks-down, rate-pressure structure. Native-language reporting in Arabic, Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Russian, French, German, Spanish and other lanes repeated the structure with different local interpretations.

World and Singapore overlay

Nepal-China disaster: by late 31 August, current reports focused on hundreds of workers feared trapped in hydropower tunnels, damaged transport access and fast-changing casualty totals. The editorial must use one source-time per number and keep infrastructure implications separate from casualty reporting.

Singapore: MAS announced S\$220 million over three years for the next phase of fintech innovation and also listed a local-currency transaction framework for bilateral trade. These are resilience and financial-infrastructure signals, not proof that Singapore is insulated from global oil or rate pressure.

Oil is rising, bonds are falling, and only a few AI shares are holding up.

A fresh U.S.-Iran exchange near the Strait of Hormuz pushed oil higher again. The energy shock is now stronger than it was in the morning edition.

Higher oil can keep inflation fear alive. That matters because the market was already pricing a greater chance of tighter U.S. policy after Kevin Warsh's Jackson Hole speech.

The evening tape is split. Oil is up more than 2%. Long bonds and small shares are down. Gold is also down. NVIDIA is positive while Apple, Meta and Alphabet are negative.

This is not one simple risk-on or risk-off move. Energy, rates and AI demand are moving through different channels at the same time.

The Nepal-China flood disaster has also moved into a new stage. Rescue teams are focused on hydropower tunnels, roads and cross-border access. The current event is now also an infrastructure and early-warning test.

Watch verified tanker traffic, Brent and WTI follow-through, U.S. yields, TLT, small-cap breadth, NVIDIA relative strength and one source-timed Nepal rescue update.

Eight Reuters links are not a 75-engine multilingual source manifest. A source list must show root ownership, language, time and deduplication.

Repeated translated wire copy is still one reporting chain. Language variety is not the same as independent evidence.

Headline tone never decides whether a prediction is a HIT or MISS. The saved entry, direction and exact deadline do.
